Summary

The fundamental purpose of the Crisis Safe Bed Program is to provide a safe, supportive environment for individuals in crisis to stabilize and defuse their present situation.

Responsibilities

- Provide on-site support/intervention to individuals residing in crisis safe bed program
- Provide coaching and skill teaching to clients within a community safe bed / residential setting, including crisis and illness management, coping skills, supportive interacting, goal setting
- Make referrals to appropriate services
- Conduct assessments and work at goal planning with individuals regarding their needs and level of support required
- Develop individual crisis and post stay plans with clients
- Observe, assess and record client activities
- Liaise with other staff and community partners as necessary with respect to individual clients
- Assist with the day to day operations of the program

Qualifications

- Completed post secondary education in the social/health science disciplines
- Minimum of one year experience in the mental health field
- Experience in the delivery of community supports to those living with mental illness and/or dual diagnosis
- Demonstrated understanding of the psychosocial rehabilitation, crisis intervention principles
- Strong assessment and active listening skills
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of the justice system
- Flexible with demonstrated ability to work independently, as well as within a team
- Possess a valid Ontario drivers licence and own a dependable vehicle
- Satisfactory police records search and vulnerable sector screening
